MARINE BIOLOGY POSITION CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

The Department of Marine Biology and the Leon H. Charney School of Marine Sciences at the University of Haifa, Israel, invites applications from outstanding scientists for tenure-track faculty positions in Marine Biotechnology, Biological Oceanography, Development and Evolution of Marine Organisms, Marine Ecology and related fields. We encourage interdisciplinary applications from scientists in related fields with a strong interest in marine biology and focused plans for marine biology-related research. Our preference is for a middle career researcher or a senior researcher.

Candidates should have a Ph.D. degree and postdoctoral experience as well as a strong track record in research and teaching. Successful candidates will be expected to carry out independent research programs, participate in collaborative projects within and outside the Leon H. Charney School of Marine Sciences and teach introductory and advanced courses at the undergraduate and graduate levels in their respective field.

The Leon H. Charney School of Marine Sciences is a unique initiative on a global scale, applying an interdisciplinary approach to studying the sea, its occupants and how the sea impacts – and is affected by – human society. As part of the University of Haifa, we are located within minutes' drive of the Mediterranean Sea, in a multicultural and diverse campus hosting more than 16,500 students. The young department of Marine Biology currently comprises seven research groups, studying a variety of marine systems in the laboratory and in the field. We provide an active and stimulating research environment, performing cutting-edge research and educating the next generation of leaders in marine biology.

Applications should include:

1. A one-page cover letter with the applicant's credentials.
2. A CV.
3. List of publications.
4. Research statement (3 pages).
5. Teaching statement (1-2 pages).
6. Names of three leading scientists who can send recommendation letters
7. Three of the applicant's best journal publications.

Final decisions are subject to the candidate's proficiency and experience, acceptance by the Department of Marine Biology, resource availability, and the approval of the Dean of the Faculty and the Rector of the University.
