



Mediterranean B Course Spring 2021 (227.4017)

Mondays, 10:00 - 12:00

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The course focuses on topics related to the Mediterranean, from natural sciences, through the humanities and social sciences, to politics and current-day policies. The course is presented in two semesters. In semester B it covers the subjects related to the Mediterranean oceanography (from ocean circulations to biological maritime societies and pollution) and to human factor (especially paleoenvironment and trade). Each lecture is given by an expert in the field and will be preceded by reading material. Participation in the lectures and tours is mandatory.

Assignments and grade composition:

- Full presence as this semester the course is online it is mandatory to have the cameras turned on **for the duration of the talk**. Students who do not adhere to this rule will fail the class. If you have a special reason for turning off the camera, please contact us.
- Grade: 60% written assignment, 20% presentation, 20% reading assignments.
 - Written assignment on a chosen topic, in the form of a research proposal. Teamwork is possible in groups up to 3 students. The deadline for submission will be one month after the final lecture – 14.7.2021. A one-page abstract should be delivered in the middle of the semester.
 - Brief presentations (15 min) will be given in the two final meetings of the semester.
 - Reading assignments every week: read paper and post three related questions on Moodle.

Assignment detail:

You will be asked to write a short research proposal describing your research questions and a detailed research plan to answer it. The research topic can be based on one of the topics presented in this course during the year, or from a list that will be provided later on. In the research plan you should explain the theoretical background, knowledge gaps, objectives and methodologies you will use, based on contents provided during the course. Final proposal is restricted by 5 pages of text + 2 pages of figures (not obligatory) + references. Abstract is restricted by 300 words. Timetable and preliminary results may be excluded. Format requirements: Times New Roman font, size 12, line space 1.5, and margins of 2 cm.
